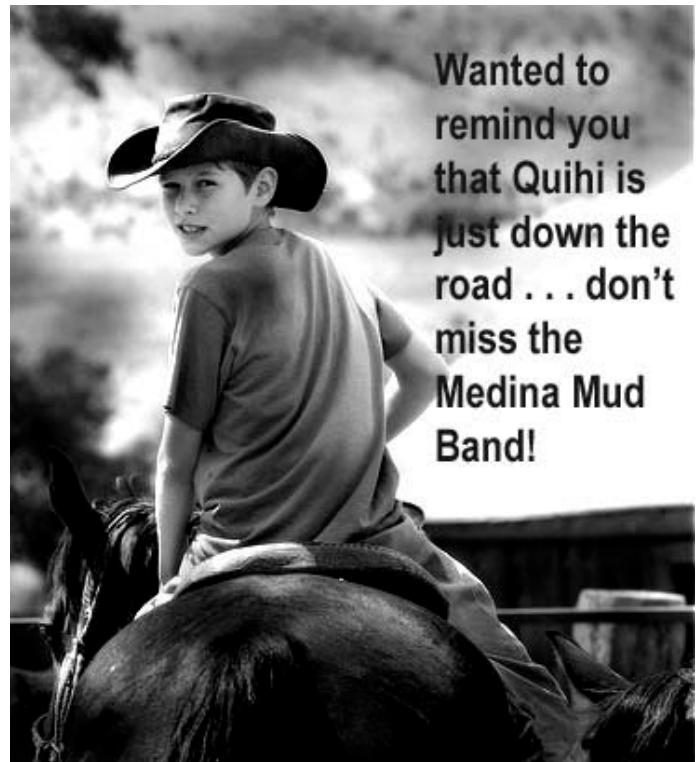


Howdy, Y'all - It's Quihi Time again!

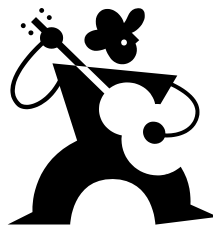

DIRECTIONS

- Take the left fork - you're nearly there!
